In order to apply for affiliate status, please send a statement that includes the following information to affiliates@gsole.org:

- a link to the organization's web address
- a link to the organization's constitution and bylaws
- a brief description of proposed collaboration and benefits to the organization and GSOLE
- a statement summarizing the organization's inclusivity, diversity, equity, and accessibility (IDEA) efforts to date
- a confirmation of the organization's 501(c) status
