- **18** individuals have completed certification with **8** more on track to finish the certification this year
- New tiered cost scale based on rank and salary (contingent/graduate student rate \$100)

### 2022 Conference Highlights

- 23 Committee Members
- 160 attendees
- 2 plenary sessions; 7 concurrent sessions spanning from 7:45 am to 7:10 pm eastern

- Proposal acceptance rate of 95% (included those offered mentoring)
